



U.S. Motor Vehicle Deaths and Rates 1993-2016








Motor Vehicle Crashes #1 cause of death for ages 5-24











Percentage of Adults Who Smoke Cigarettes: 1965-2014



Seat Belt Use: 1981-2016










Trauma Center Access by Helicopter
